#### FUNDAMENTAL CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. **Dress Code**: Students are required to follow the dress code prescribed by the Institute; this cultivates a sense of equality amongst the students from diverse backgrounds.
- 2. **Honesty**: We cultivate honesty in all walks of campus life. Malpractices in exams and in research we have a plagiarism policy and software as well.
- 3. **Transparent Administration**: All our administrative procedures are written down and made available to the students so that no secrecy is entertained.
- 4. **Disciplined Conduct**: Any conduct obstructing teaching, research, administration, other proceedings or activities in the campus liable to punishment.
- 5. **Respect for women**: Students must see that their behavior or action is impeccable toward opposite gender. Any unwelcome behavior towards female students and employees in written, spoken, gestural or physical directly or indirectly would be dealt with as per the Law. There is ICC in the college to deal with such affairs.
- 6. **National anthem**: The day starts with National Anthem followed by observance if any. Thought of the day is displayed on the notice board.
- 7. **Prohibition of Ragging**: We strictly follow the UGC guidelines regarding ragging. Any unwelcome action spoken or written, which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling the fresher or any other student with rudeness will be treated as ragging.
- 8. **Hostel Discipline**: There are rules and regulations are laid down for conduct in Hostels has to be strictly followed by each student.
- 9. **Drugs / Alcohol / Tobacco**: Exchange, sale, distribution, manufacture use and possession of drugs that are not prescribed by physician or are not legal in the open market are prohibited. Alcohol and Tobacco products are also prohibited in the Campus and in the Hostel and in the adjacent areas.
- 10. Possession or use of Fire arms, Fireworks, explosives, weapons or items of destruction are prohibited.
- 11. **Cleanliness:** Every student and staff is expected to maintain the general cleanliness within the classrooms, laboratories and the campus in general.



#### CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- 1. Every student must wear uniform prescribed by the college and must carry his/her identity card and produce it when asked.
- 2. Every student is expected to maintain the general cleanliness within the classrooms, laboratories and the campus premises.
- 3. Any act that obstructs teaching, research, administrative activity and other proceedings of the college is strictly prohibited.
- 4. Chewing paan, masala, gutka or any other tobacco products, smoking or consumption of any other intoxicating products is strictly prohibited.
- 5. Playing cards, spitting and loitering are strictly prohibited inside the college & hostel campus and shall invite severe punishment/disciplinary action.
- 6. Use of Cell phones is strictly prohibited during class hour.
- 7. Attempted or actual theft of and/or damage to property of the College, or property of a member of the College community, or other personal or public property, on or off campus will be considered as a punishable act.
- 8. During leisure hours, students are advised to use the library as maximum as possible.
- 9. Students should handle the college properties with care. Damage to the furniture or any other materials may lead to penalty or suspension from the college.
- 10. Indulging ragging, anti-institutional, anti-national, antisocial, communal, immoral or political expressions and activities within the Campus and hostel are strongly prohibited as well as punishable.
- 11. Without the permission of the Principal, Students are not allowed to circulate any printed materials within the college campus.
- 12. Student should not form any group or forum on the campus without seeking the prior permission of Principal in writing
- 13. Student should not invite any person for organizing a meeting or program without prior permission of Principal in writing
- 14. A student should maintain at least 75% attendance in the Lectures of every subject and 100% overall performance. Otherwise, he or she will be debarred from the University Examination.
- 15. Authorities have full right to modify the rules whenever necessary and following of such modified rules is obligatory for the students. In case of any dispute Principal's decision will be final.
- 16. Students are required to check the Notice Board and also website of the college for important announcements.



# Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institution, 2009.

(The Regulation is available on the UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in. These regulations are mandatory for all higher educational institutions in the country.)

Students will follow all the norms of discipline of this college. Rules regarding routine work, behavior in the campus, classrooms, and library at various functions and during examinations should be properly observed by all students. The regulations jointly made by the Educational Council, State Government and College Management will have to be strictly followed by all students.

- 11. Shouting, causing nuisance, banging on the college property.
- 12. Visitors are not allowed on the campus unless special permission is granted.
- 13. Students will have to follow all rules made my laboratories, library, Hostel & Canteen.
- 14. Without permission students are not allowed to enter on the terrace or in the garden.
- 1. Study tours (only if included in curriculum) can be arranged with prior permission of Principal in writing. College will not be responsible for the tours conducted without permission.
- 15. In case of any complaint contact the Principal. Do not directly approach the newspaper or any other media.
- 16. Use of unfair means and copy material in the examination is a punishable offence.
- 17. Original Certificate once submitted will not be returned.
- 18. Strict action will be taken if any alternations in documents are made.
- 19. No circles, organizations other than academic forums of students are formed in the campus.
- 20. The examinations forms will be detained if students are having less than 75% attendance.
- 21. Students will have to observe all other regulations made from time to time by the college authorities.

**RAGGING**: The institution shall punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure and in the manner prescribed here in under:

A) The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad.

B) The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely;

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel.
- Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- He / She will have to undergo the legal proceedings
- C) Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
