The Department of Chemistry with Competitive Examination Cell organized 'NET/SET Guidance Workshop' 02/03/2019 in Audio Visual Room No 4. Professor Dr. G. S. Rashinkar, Department of Chemistry, Shivaji University, Kolhapur, was invited as the resource person. Dr. D. S. Salunke, Vice Principal, welcomed resource person by offering bouquet and a book. Dr. S. D. Pardeshi introduced the resource person. This workshop was held in two sessions: 11.00 to 2.00 pm and 2.30 pm to 5.00 pm.

In the first session, Dr. G. S. Rashinkar explained the structure of the NET - SET examination, common syllabus of paper and the recurrent areas focused. He took up some of the questions asked in the previous examinations. He also explained mark distribution for Paper I. He said that many students are good at their domain area but are not able to crack the first paper. That's why they fail and feel that the examination is very hard. However, it is not so. Consistent practice is the key to success.

In second session he emphasized on the paper II syllabus and the types of questions asked in the examination. He explained the common mistakes committed by the students and also suggested the ways to overcome such problems. He said that there are opportunities to students to be senior college teachers. He said that he has motivated more than 1000 students so far and found that most of them have got success. He also conducted an interactive session towards the end of the workshop and answered the queries and difficulties raised by the participants. He shared a list of reference books with the participants. The students had attitudinal changes after attending the workshop. 67 students of PG classes participated in the workshop.
