Purpose of the activity: To aware the students about the impact of human activities on environment

Details:

On the occasion of World Environment Day on 05 June 2021, NSS and Science forum jointly conducted an online quiz competition on environmental issues through Google Forms to create awareness among students about the "impact of man-made factors on the environment". In the exam, total 20 environmental questions were asked. These included questions on environmental protection, greenhouse gas emissions, dense forest projects, the Kyoto Protocol etc.

Through this test, the students became aware of the adverse environmental changes. The score obtained in this examination were immediately communicated to the students. The examination was divided into two groups viz. 1. Undergraduate and 2. Postgraduate. The first three students in the exam were given participation certificates in this exam. In this exam, 17 students from B.A., 86 students from B.Sc., 98 students from B.Com., 33 students from M.Sc., 18 students from M.Com. Thus, totally 252 college students participate (201 undergraduates and 51 postgraduate students participated.)

Overall impact of the program: Students were aware about the environmental issues.
