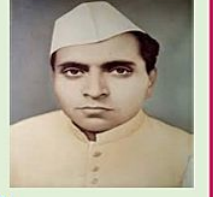

'Thoughts of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar: Contemporary Relevance'

To commemorate the Name Extension Day of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad, Prof. V. R. Parsode, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science, delivered a lecture. This activity was held under the aegis of Social Science Association. Dr. C. V. Sirsat, Principal, presided over the programme. Prof. K. S. Ban, Coordinator, Social Science Association shared the objective of the lecture. Prof. V. S. Doke, Head, Department of Political Science, welcomed the speaker, Prof. V. R. Parsode.

Prof. V. R. Parsode said that the thoughts of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar have ever lasting relevance because they address the aspirations of humanity as a whole. He said that historically, a handful of powerful people have always tried to enslave the majority lot in order to safeguard their selfish interests. So commitment for democracy is the hallmark of Dr. Ambedkar's vision. He informed that in today's context Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar has universal relevance. He said that Dr. Ambedkar was basically a visionary social reformer and when he realized that the lot of the downtrodden society could not be improved unless some legal provisions are made, he decided to step into the field of politics. He strongly believed that eternal vigilance is the price of democracy. So he called upon the masses to unite and take active part in the political processes. He said that unity is the strength. He stressed that education is important in order to make conscious decision. Prof. Parsode said that provincialism, racism, rural-urban divide, untouchability, human right violation have started creeping its ugly head and this is the real challenge before democracy. In the Middle East the condition has deteriorated drastically. It's time the world has to express solidarity for the restoration of democracy. In the presidential remarks, Dr. C. V. Sirsat said that the thoughts of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar have great significance. He said that India has always helped the world with vibrant ideas and in this critical scenario too the vision of Dr. Ambedkar will show us direction. Mr. A. S. Kasbe proposed the vote of thanks.
