The lecture was given by Mrs. Vaishali Shelke. In the beginning of the programme Mrs. Shelke Madam was welcomed by Mr. K.S. Ban. Mrs. Vaishali Shelke Madam, at the outset of her discourse pointed out that artificial intelligence which was considered distant reality is now the part of our life. It was experienced by us only in science fiction and movies based on science. She told what is the general assumption when people hear the term artificial intelligence, the first thing they usually think of is robots. That's because big-budget films and novels weave stories about human-like machines that wreak havoc on earth. But nothing could be further from the truth. The term is frequently applied to the project of developing systems endowed with the intellectual processes characteristic of humans, such as the ability to reason, discover meaning, generalize, or learn from past experience. Artificial intelligence is based on the principle that human intelligence can be defined in a way that a machine can easily mimic it and execute tasks, from the most simple to those that are even more complex. The goals of artificial intelligence include mimicking human cognitive activity. Researchers and developers in the field are making surprisingly rapid strides in mimicking activities such as learning, reasoning, and perception, to the extent that these can be concretely defined. Some believe that innovators may soon be able to develop systems that exceed the capacity of humans to learn or reason out any subject. But others remain sceptical because all cognitive activity is laced with value judgments that are subject to human experience. Artificial intelligence (AI) is intelligence demonstrated by machines, as opposed to the natural intelligence displayed by animals including humans. AI research has been defined as the

field of study of intelligent agents, which refers to any system that perceives its environment and takes actions that maximize its chance of achieving its goals. At the end of her lecture Mrs Shelke pointed out that Artificial Intelligence is probably the most complex and astounding creations of humanity yet. And that is disregarding the fact that the field remains largely unexplored, which means that every amazing AI application that we see today represents merely the tip of the AI iceberg, as it were. While this fact may have been stated and restated numerous times, it is still hard to comprehensively gain perspective on the potential impact of AI in the future. The reason for this is the revolutionary impact that AI is having on society, even at such a relatively early stage in its evolution.

The session came to end with vote of thanks by Mr. S.K. Rathod. The lecture was attended by faculty members.

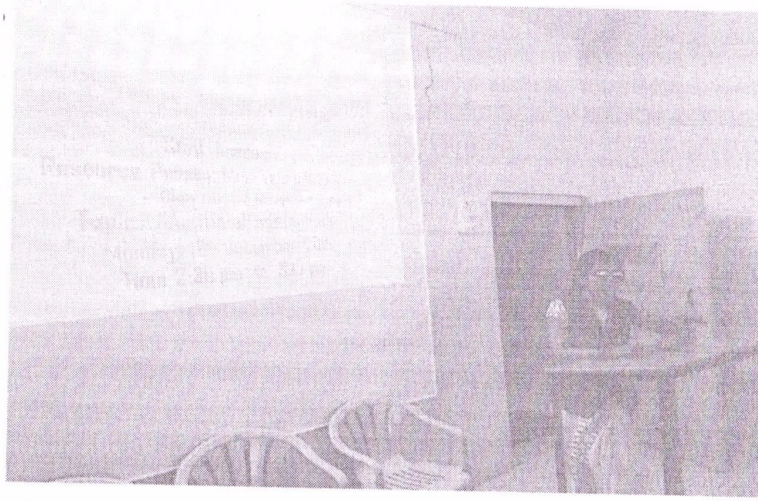
