REPORT

National Service Scheme devoted one whole week for tree plantation and conservation from 01-07-2016 to 07-07-2016. The aim of this drive was to generate awareness amongst the students and the volunteers about role of trees in the environment, dignity of labour and methods of nature conservation. The Programmes Officers prepared a comprehensive action programme in this regard and conducted activities like campus cleaning, plastic collection, tree plantation, tree conservation etc.

Dr. S. D. Hiwale sensitized the volunteers about the importance of tree plantation and told the students that Vinayakrao Patil Mahavidyalaya, Vaijapur has a rich variety of plants. He said that the extensive campus of about 20 acres has been instrumental in maintaining a variety of plants. He said that we live in a drought prone area and we have some natural constraints in nature conservation. Despite all the adversities, the NSS volunteers have taken pains in planting and conserving trees. This is why today we boast of a very eco-friendly and green educational campus in the region.

The NSS volunteers prepared the saplings of tamarind, gulmohar, subabul, blackboard (Saptaparni) etc. The students made 100 saplings ready for plantation while others dug 100 pits for plantation purpose. A group of volunteers mixed black soil, sand, murum and manure in proportion in order to ensure water percolation. The programme officers Dr. S. D. Hiwale, Dr. K. P. Bholane, Mr. S. A. Dokhe guided the students.
