**Lecture on "Live to Donate"**  
**Report**  
**29-02-2020**

NSS organized the lecture of 'Live to Donate' under the campaign of 'organ donation' on 29 February 2020. Dr. Jayant Sonar was present as resource person for this programme. Dr. Kishor Bholane, Programme Officer, welcomed him and gave his brief introduction to the audience. Dr. Sonar talked about the critical condition of organ failure in older as well as young people. He introduced the concept of organ donation as it is the process of surgically removing an organ or tissue from one person (the organ donor) and placing it into another person (the recipient). Transplantation is necessary because the recipient's organ has failed or has been damaged by disease or injury. He further told that many people are dying only because they are not getting organ transplantation on time. He told that more than 21 body parts are transplantable that includes Liver, Kidney, Pancreas, Heart, Lung, Intestine, Cornea, Middle ear, Skin, Bone, Bone marrow, Heart valves, Connective tissue, Vascularized composite allografts (transplant of several structures that may include skin, bone, muscles, blood vessels, nerves, and connective tissue).

Dr. Sonar told that any fit person or dead person can donate his organs subject to some conditions. People of all ages may be the potential donors. When a person dies, he or she is evaluated for donor suitability based on their medical history and age. The Organ Procurement Agency determines medical suitability for donation. The organ is offered first to the transplant center with the candidate who is the best match. The transplant team decides if it will accept or refuse the organ based on established medical criteria and other factors, including staff and patient availability and organ transportation. If the transplant center refuses the organ, the transplant center of the next patient on the list is contacted and the process continues until the organ is placed. Organs are distributed locally first; if no match is found, they are offered regionally and then nationally.

He told about the national agency National Organ and Tissue Transplant Organization makes pivotal role in organ transplantation. A person can register for organ donation or transplantation on the website <https://notto.gov.in/> He also told about the toll free number for organ donation.

He further told the statistical data of India. In India alone, every year 5,00,000 people die because of non-availability of organs, 200,000 people die due to liver disease, and 50,000 people die because of heart disease. Moreover, 1,50,000 people await a kidney transplant but only 5,000 get among them. But when the death data is observed, daily 22,500 people dies because of various reason. If these persons had registered for the organ donation, then this problem will be solved within few days. Everyone would get the transplantations. Finally he urged the volunteers to pledge for organ donation in future. The programme was concluded after the vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Kishor Bholane.


