**Lecture on 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' by Prof. B. K. Nikam

**REPORT**

Prof. B. K. Nikam expressed his thoughts on the topic 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' on 29-12-2019. Anil Vilas Jagtap welcomed the resource person.

Prof. Nikam said that on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2014, Prime Narendra Modi launched a significant campaign named 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan'. Its aim was to make India a clean nation by 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2019 which marks the 150<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. He added that 'Clean and Hygienic India' was the dream of Mahatma Gandhi and throughout his life he exhorted the people around him to maintain cleanliness. On 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2014, the Prime Minister Narendra Modi picked up a broom himself and cleaned the streets in Delhi. It was a symbolic move and the whole nation stood behind him. Now the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan has become a mass movement in India. The PM called upon the people not to spread litter and not to let other people spread it.

Prof. B. K. Nikam pointed out that India is a developing country. Our economy is one of the fast developing economy in the world. However, in order to be a developing and developed nation we have to look into other domains of life. Human development index is very crucial in order to be a developed nation. When our streets are full of litter and water bodies are polluted and contaminated, we cannot realize the dream of a progressed nation. So it is our solemn duty to be an active participant in this noble mission.

He further said that remarkable changes are taking place around us. The streets in our villages and towns are clean. This is why the Municipal Council of Vaijapur has geared up and now we have good garbage collection and treatment facility. We have planted more than 10000 trees in the length and breathe of the town. So the town has become green. Therefore, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is a comprehensive public movement. He exhorted the students to be responsible citizens of India by taking part in the movement. Sandeep Krushna Gaikwad proposed the vote of thanks and conducted the proceeding.
