**NET SET GUIDANCE WORKSHOP**

The Department of Political Science organized a one day workshop on NET/SET for the PG students on 02/02/2017. The purpose of this activity was to help students understand the structure of both the papers.

Mr. V. S. Doke, Head, Department of Political Science gave a brief introduction about the workshop. He said that every year thousands of students appear for the SRT/NET examinations. However, students have certain difficulties in this regard. He also stated that many students from this college prepare for these examinations. However, it is important to understand that the examination starts from Paper I which is about the general understanding of the students.

In the first session, Dr. Dadasaheb Salunke, Assistant Professor, Department of English, guided the students about the analytical type of questions and educational psychology. The first paper consists of 50 question. It is called as Teaching/Research aptitude exam. The duration is 1 hour 15 minutes. Maximum marks are 100. He said that these questions are often repeated and so we have to bear in mind that we have to practice certain techniques like percentage, geometrical shapes, area, data handling, current affairs, information and technology etc.

In the next session, Mr. V. R. Parsode, delivered a lecture regarding Paper II. This paper carries 50 questions total 100 marks. It is common for all aspirants. Paper II tries to assess the subject knowledge of the candidate. Paper II carries 50 and duration is 1 hour 15 minutes. Paper II carries 75 questions for 150 marks and duration is 2 hours and 30 minutes.

The key syllabus components are Political Theory, Political Thought, Indian Political Thought, Comparative Political Analysis, International Relations, India's Foreign Policy, Political Institutions in India, Political Processes in India, Public Administration, Governance and Public Policy in India. Mr. Abasaheb Kasbe proposed the vote of thanks. Total 34 students participated in the workshop.
