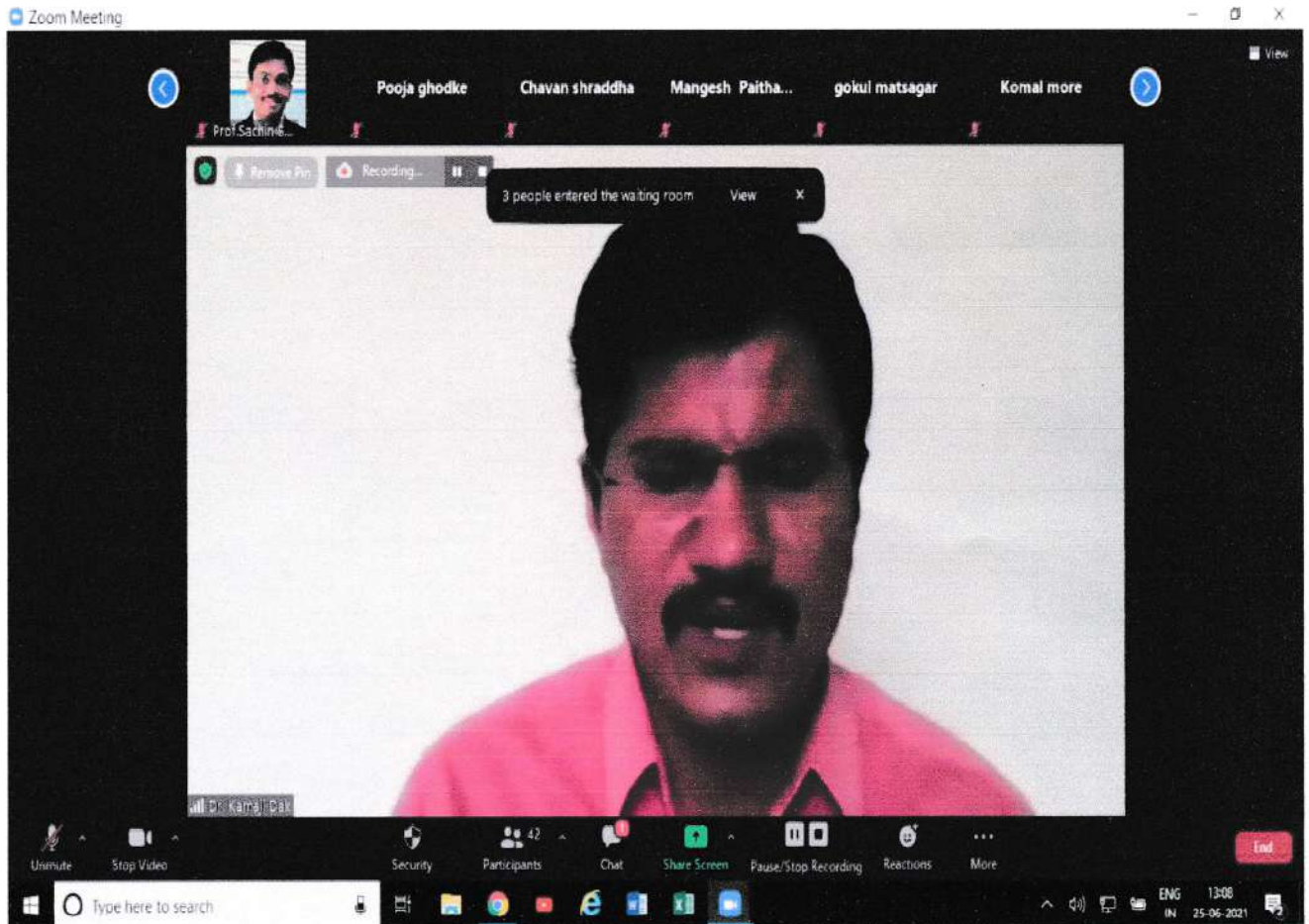

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES IN HISTORY AND TOURISM
(25 June 2021)
REPORT

The Department of History organized an online one day workshop on Career Opportunities in History and Tourism on 25/06/2021. The objective of this workshop was to introduce various career opportunities in tourism field. Dr. Dadasaheb Salunke, IQAC Coordinator, Vinayakrao Patil Mahavidyalaya, gave a brief introduction to the workshop and welcomed all the participants.

We invited two resource persons for this workshop. In the first session that commenced at 01:00 pm, Dr. Kamaji Dak, Coordinator, Department of Archaeology, Government of Maharashtra, Aurangabad Division, gave an informative lecture on 'Archaeology and Museum'. He shared that after UG, students should explore a large number of opportunities available in the field of tourism. They can do Diploma in Archaeology too. The central Government recruits many young and talented candidates in this field. He also acquainted the students with various historical sites which have emerged as the tourist destinations in the last three decades. He added that there are lakes, palaces, temples, hill stations where students can start their own business. Many students learn Modi script and get recruitment in government departments. Coin collection could also be a hobby because tourists like to view these collections and pay for it.

In the second session held at 02:00 pm, Dr. Arvind Sontakke, Head, Department of History, Digambarrao Bindu Mahavidyalaya, Bhokar – Nanded, delivered a PPT presentation on the topic 'Career Opportunities in Tourism'. In his brilliant and lucid presentation, Dr. Sontakke revealed that there are huge opportunities in tourism sector in India. We need to show to the world our handicrafts and visual arts, social practices, rituals, festive events, music and performing arts, oral traditions and expressions. He reiterated that India has a tradition of 'Atithi Devo Bhav' and harnessing this fundamental character, we must explore the scope in this field. He further added that in order to tap the opportunities, we must change our attitude because many students feel that working in restaurants is a menial job. In fact, the students should see that no occupation is menial. In Maharashtra also we are running short of skilled people required in tourism industry. If the students speak Marathi, Hindi and English, obtain the knowledge about these places, they can serve as the guides at the tourist sites. However, we have to change the approach. He gave 'Six S' formula that can change India into a global tourist hub. In that we have to bring about some structural changes in our system. Security of tourists is a major concern. Otherwise, we have a bright future in this field. After both the sessions were over, there was a Q & A segment in which five students participated. Dr. Arvind Sontakke answered their questions. 53 students participated in this workshop.

In the last session, Prof. K. S. Ban, Head, Department of History, delivered the presidential address. In his summing up, he said that the students should not select only the traditional career options. There is a plenty of scope for History students. The only thing is that you have to sharpen your skills. At the end, Prof. Parasram Shelke, Assistant Professor, Department of History, presented the Vote of Thanks.
